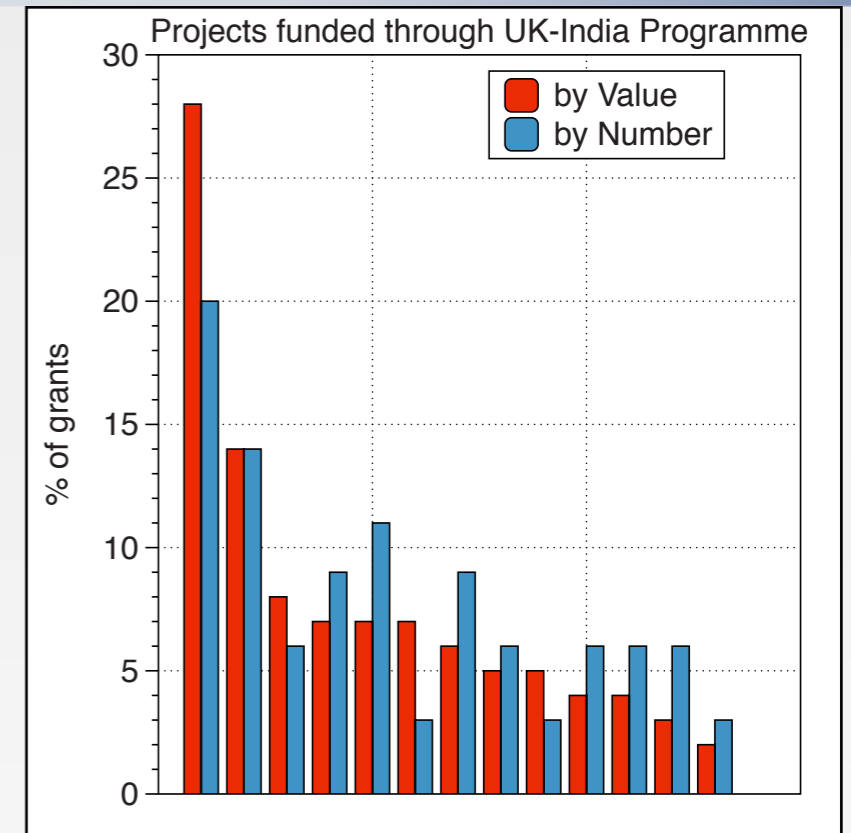

Network funded for five years - official launch soon...

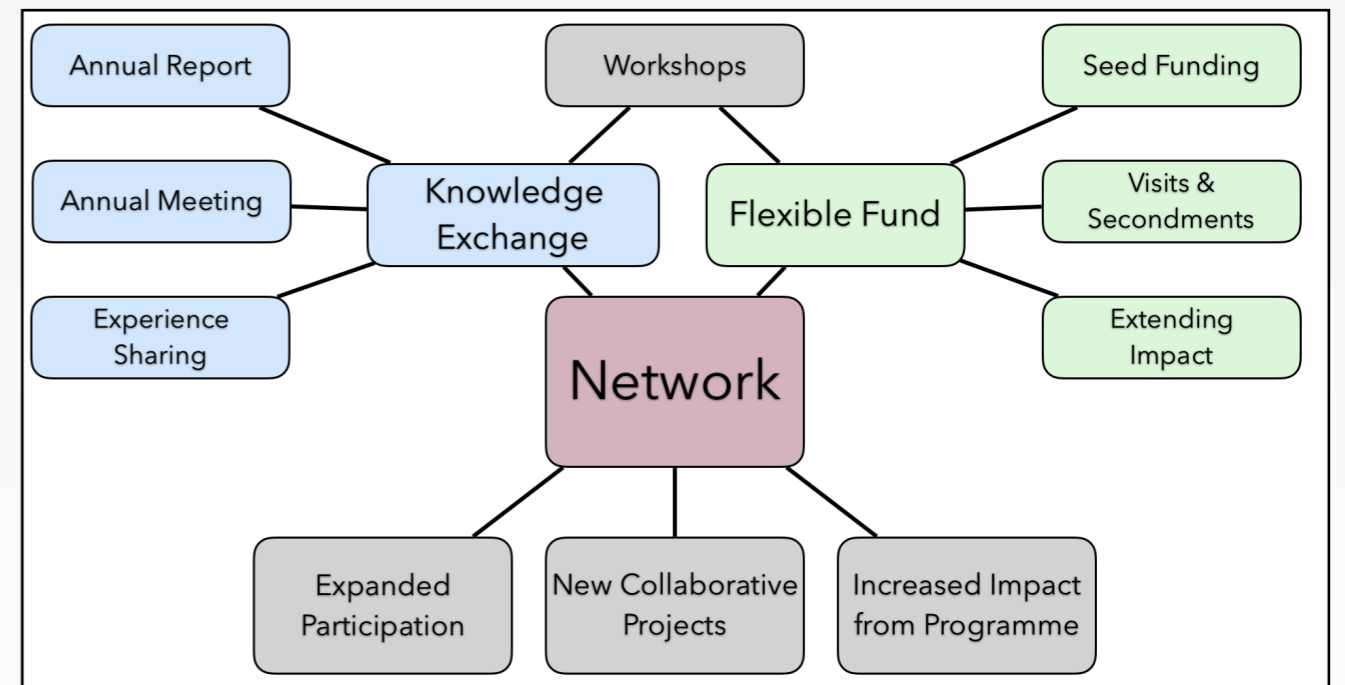
Aims

- Raise impact from the UK-India Nuclear Programme

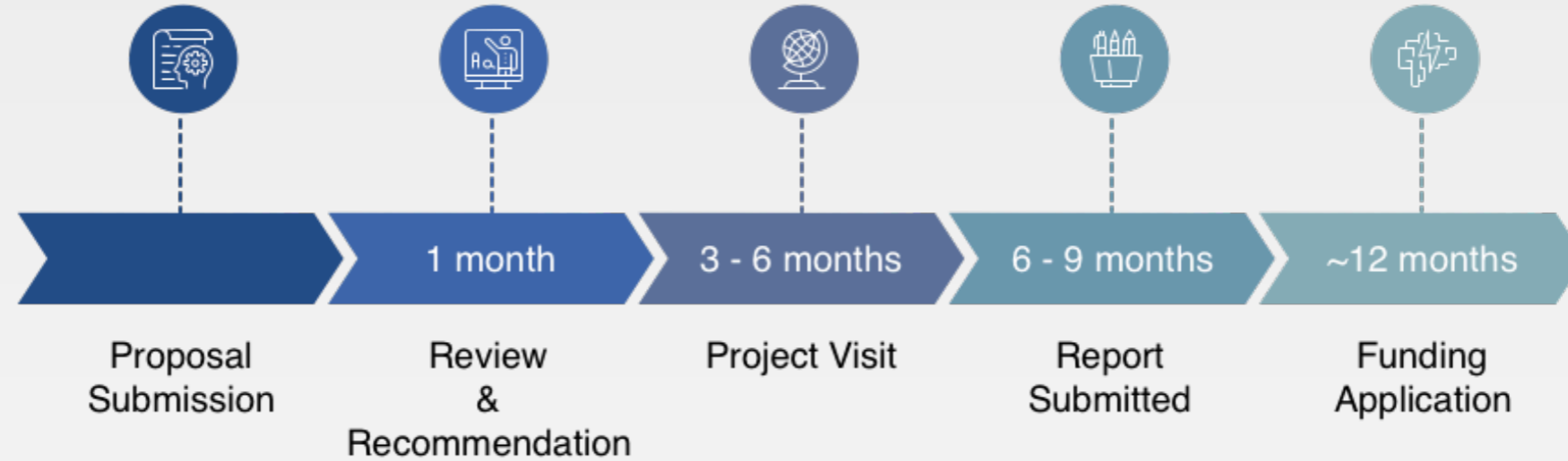


Flexible Funding
