



The Nuclear Island Big Rig programme immerses engineering students in a hands-on engineering experience working under the simulated conditions of a nuclear-licensed site. In just five days, students assemble, commission and operate a mock-up of a real engineered system from the nuclear energy generation lifecycle, be it the primary loop from a new-build station, or an evaporator unit from a processing plant.

There are now two Big Rig facilities offering Nuclear Island Big Rig events:

- The Big Rig: Bridgwater – situated close to Hinkley point power station
- The Big Rig: Britain's Energy Coast – situated close to Sellafield
